VIÑA BOSCONIA TINTO, RESERVA, BODEGAS R. LÓPEZ DE HEREDIA, RIOJA, SPAIN 2006 £50

López de Heredia are older than Rioja itself and their style remains staunchly traditional; the best fruit, from the finest single vineyards with long aging in old oak. Unique wines of impeccable character.

BAROLO, BRUNATE, MARCARINI PIEDMONT, ITALY 2014 £60

Hints of liquorice, tamarind, clove and rose; dominated by kirsch cherry, mentholated and dried fruits.

CLOUDY BAY PINOT NOIR MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND 2016 £16 £22 £65

Bright and pretty with an abundance of strawberry and red cherry fruit, energetic yet gentle structure.

CHÂTEAU BRANE-CANTENAC, MARGAUX BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2014 £140

Margaux is the most feminine of the Bordeaux communes, almost Burgundian elegance, floral personality.

WHITE WINE

GRECANICO, IGT TERRE SICILIANE COLLE DEL SOLE, ITALY 2016 £7 £9 £26

Simple, light and fruity, the Grecanico grape, an Italian native, offers a whiff of tropical fruit and aperitif freshness.

BERRY BROS. & RUDD, 'MERCHANT'S WHITE' CARIÑENA, SPAIN 2017 £9 £11 £32

The international appeal of Chardonnay brings weight, stoniness and pleasing peach fruit here whilst some Old Vine Viura offers a satisfying texture on the palate.

PICPOUL DE PINET, DOMAINE FÉLINES JOURDAN LANGUEDOC, FRANCE 2018 £33

The Languedoc's classic seafood wine offers a nose of bright citrus amplified by the crisp zing of sea air. This is a wine of broad appeal, with or without food, but is most at home with classic fruits of the sea.

FALERIO DEL COLLI ASCOLANI, SALADINI PILASTRI MARCHE, ITALY 2016 £34

Made from Trebbiano combined with two little known Italian varieties; Pecarino and Passerina, full-bodied yet elegant this is a worthy reflection of its rustic origins and organic practices.

BERRY BROS. & RUDD PINOT GRIGIO DELLE VENEZIE BY NEC OTIUM FRIULI, ITALY 2017 £36

A wine which brilliantly demonstrates Pinot Grigio's prowess as a serious wine. Hillside vineyards and long ripening ensure that this has a generous fruit character and a sense of vivacity.

EL CAMINO RECTORAL DO UMIA ALBARIÑO RÍAS BAIXAS D.O., SPAIN 2017 £38

Pale lemon green in colour with notes of pink grapefruit, ripe pear, honeydew melon, cantaloupe and some delicious apple. Light on the palate with apple, melon and floral notes, even a hint of butterscotch. Light and refreshing.

PALE CLOUDS SAUVIGNON BLANC MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND 2018 £12 £15 £40

The unmistakable personality of New Zealand Sauvignon remains a firm favourite and it's easy to see why with this gooseberry fuelled, asparagus tinged, lime fruited and zippy example.

RIESLING SONNENBERG, EYMANN PFALZ, GERMANY 2017 £41

Sourced from 30-year-old vines in the Sonnenberg vineyard, this wine has a vibrant lemon colour, with notes of grapefruit, apricot and jasmine. The palate displays crisp acidity with a concentration of white flowers and beeswax, along with a touch of spice.

GAVI DI GAVI, BRIC SASSI, ROBERTO SAROTTO PIEDMONT, ITALY 2017			£42
From Roberto's prized 'Bric Sassi' vineyard at the top of the hillside this is wonderfully multi-layered, with top notes of lemon and verbena, a backbone of chalky minerals, and a heart of almond nuttiness.			
CHABLIS, DOMAINE SÉBASTIEN DAMPT BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2017	£12.5	£15	£44
Sébastien brings his own flair to his family's 150 years of experience. One of Chablis most exciting winemakers his wines are steely fresh, yet complex, with stone and flint mingling with flowers and hazelnut.			
SANCERRE, LE CHENE MARCHAND LOIRE, FRANCE 2017	£13	£16	£46
The fruit here is grown on three different soil types, caillottes, terres blanches and marnes, giving the wine perfume, fruit and structure. The warm and sunny growing season has provided a generous wine, packed with yellow fruit notes and rounded off with a pleasant and refreshing citrus bitterness.			
ST VÉРАН, LE GRAND BUSSIÈRE, OLIVIER MERLIN BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2015			£50
Luscious and generous on the nose with faintly tropical fruit and elegantly integrated oak. The flavours are long and persistent leaving no doubt of Monsieur Merlin's master craftsmanship.			
MEURSAULT, LES GRANDS CHARRONS, DOMAINE MICHEL BOUZEREAU BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2015			£70
Subtle, lean and elegant, in the glass this blossoms with apple orchard, white flowers and a discrete whiff of toast from the oak. A little buttery note and hazelnut completes this very appealing picture.			
CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET, CHATEAU DE PULIGNY MONTRACHET BURGUNDY, FRANCE 2015			£80
Alive with orange zest, peach and a hint of ginger. This is as suave on the palate as the aromas promise, rewarding each revisit to the glass with new interest.			

ROSÉ WINE

LE CHAPEAU QUI RIT, PAYS D'HÉRAULT PROVENCE, FRANCE 2018	£12	£15	£40
The reputation of Provençal Rosé is well deserved, gloriously fruity and well balanced, poised between white wine elegance and red wine weight, this brings a smile to the lips with ease.

EL FUTURO NO ESTA ESCRITO, TEMPRANILLO/SYRAH, BODEGAS PANIZA, CARIÑENA, SPAIN 2017	£7	£9	£26
Intense, persistent aroma and a soft, savoury flavour.			
BERRY BROS. & RUDD 'MERCHANT'S RED' (MERLOT BASED) CARIÑENA, SPAIN 2017	£9	£11	£32
With Merlot at its core this has all the gentle charm of that soft, plummy variety. A little weight and a red fruit top note comes courtesy of Garnacha.			
BERRY BROS. & RUDD GOOD ORDINARY CLARET BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2016			£34
A classic and long-standing favourite; black cherries, bramble fruit and wood smoke. Instantly appealing, the palate follows through with delicious black fruit and a long, velvety finish.			
PULENTA LA FLOR MALBEC MENDOZA, ARGENTINA 2017			£40
All of the big bold fruit of Mendoza Malbec is here; the dark berries and the bright damson, alongside warm spice and chocolate. A less common feature here is the wine's wonderfully juxtaposed elegance.			
BERRY BROS. & RUDD AUSTRALIAN SHIRAZ BY ELDERTON BAROSSA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA, 2018			£42
The wine has an enticing nose of blackberries and warm plummy fruit, lifted by an appealing freshness. Soft, supple red and black fruit envelops the palate, while the tannins are smooth and fine.			
CONSTANTIA GLEN THREE, CONSTANTIA WINE VALLEY CONSTANTIA, SOUTH AFRICA, 2015			£44
Constantia is poised between two oceans, just as this wine is poised between two styles. There's a Bordeaux-like freshness here; elegant and restrained, but no shortage of new world flair. Masterclass.			
BERRY BROS. & RUDD, CHATEAU FEYTIT-CLINET POMEROL BORDEAUX, FRANCE 2016	£13	£16.5	£48
Pomerol produces arguably the finest Merlot-based wines in the world; renowned for displaying both elegance and intensity. This wine is suave and polished, with a nose dense with ripe, plummy, berry fruit.			

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
